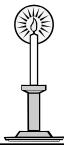

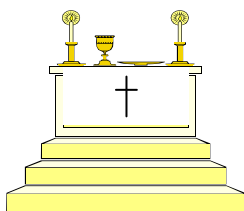

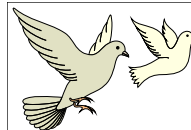

Parents for Megan's Law

The Community Service Committee is pleased to announce a new program for parents in the Three Village Area to help educate their children about personal safety. The vestry has agreed that this is an important topic and one that should be taught to children in a way that does not scare them. Though we are living in a wonderful community, we cannot forget that we must teach our children the skills they need to protect themselves.

The first program that will be brought to Caroline Church by the Parents for Megan's Law group will be on **Wednesday, August 24**, from 7 -9pm. The 1-½hour PowerPoint presentation, "Apple of My Eye" is an adult education program, not intended for children. Parents will be sent home with written material to go over and discuss with their families.

The next step in this process of education will be to share our knowledge with other denominations and begin to branch out to educate as many Long Island families as possible. Another session will run on Wednesday, October 19, just in time for Halloween. Please join us for this very important discussion.

Where are the Children? Introducing Children to Worship

Children's presence in a congregation is often seen as a sign of congregational growth and vitality. Yet children who grow up attending Sunday School during the worship hour are unfamiliar with congregational worship and all too often leave the church once they are confirmed rather than participating in the "adult" life of the church. As an alternative, this workshop offers an introduction to children's ways of worshipping and practical tools for engaging children of all ages in congregational worship. The workshop will discuss preaching practices, children's worship bulletins, sabbath toys, and other pew activities. Participants will learn how to navigate safety policies as a multigenerational church. We will also explore worship and other aspects of church life as educational opportunities for children and adults alike.
