Sunday, July 31st

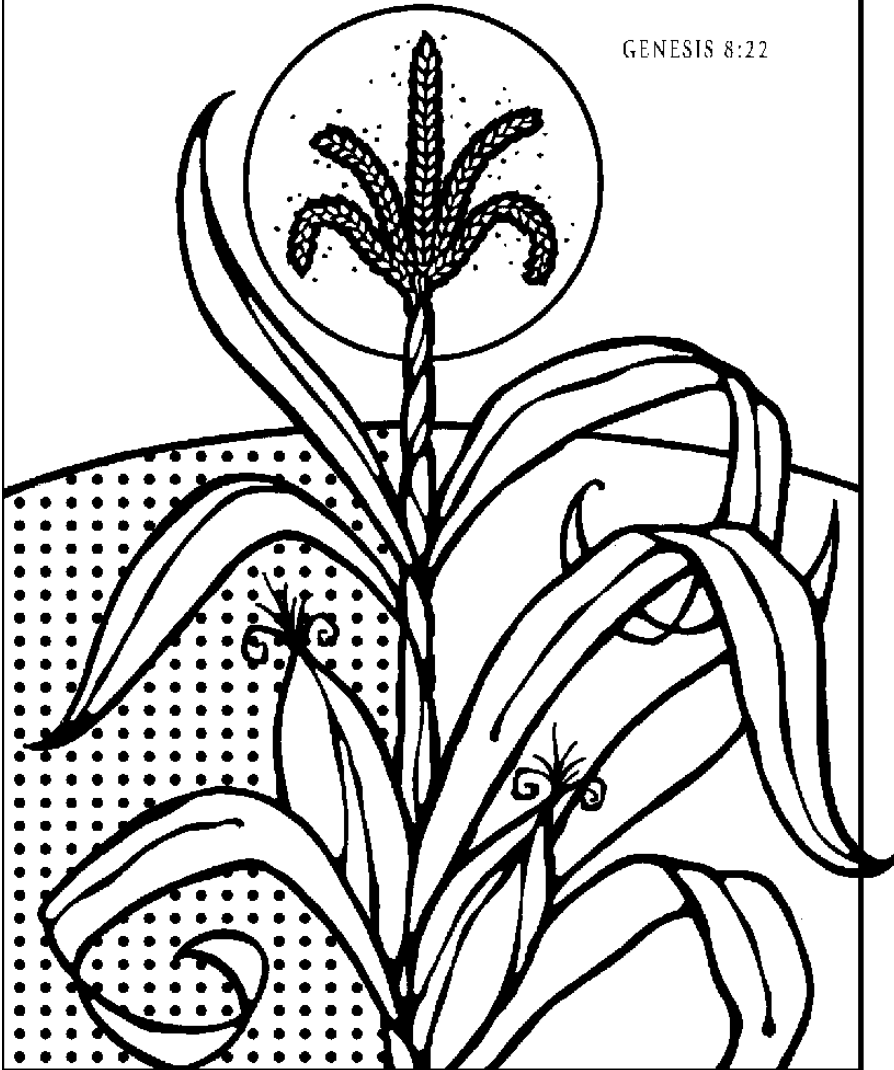

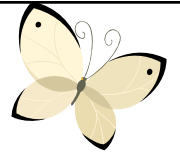
