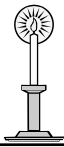

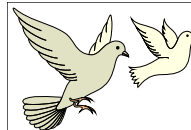

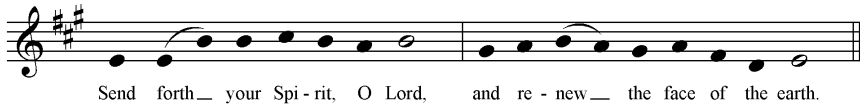

New Safe Church Policy: There are now new policies for Sexual Harassment, Sexual Exploitation, and Protection of Children and Youth in the Diocese of Long Island that each parish is to implement. To this end the Diocese has directed that on-line training be completed by all Vestry members, Leaders of groups who regularly use any church facilities, and all Key-holders.
